
## **Drug Status Report**

**Drug:** 6-hydroxy oxymorphone

**Drug Name Status**: 6-hydroxy oxymorphone is the common name

Chemical Name: (5alpha)-4,5-Epoxy-17-methylmorphinan-3,6,14-triol

**Pharmacological class / Application:** Pharmaceutical-related substances

**CAS-RN: NONE International status:** 

US: The substances are not listed specifically in the Controlled Substances Act and are not mentioned anywhere on the DEA website.

United Nations: The substances are not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: 6-hydroxy oxymorphone is a metabolite of oxymorphone and is not currently listed in the CDSA. However, oxymorphone is listed as sub-item 29 under item 1 of Schedule I under the heading "Opium Poppy (Papaver somniferum), its preparations, derivatives, alkaloids and salts including". As a metabolite of oxymorphone, 6-hydroxy oxymorphone is included under item1(29) of Schedule I to the CDSA and its deuterated derivative, 5-hydroxy oxymorphone-d3, would also be controlled under item 1(29) of Schedule I to the CDSA.

**Recommendation:** 6-hydroxy oxymorphone is included under item 10 of Schedule I to the CDSA and is a controlled substance.
