
Drug Status Report

Drug: 6-Methyl bromazepam

Drug Name Status: 6-Methyl bromazepam is the common name.

Chemical Name: 7-bromo-1,3-dihydro-5-(6-methyl-2-pyridinyl)-2H-1,4-benzodiazepin-2-one

International status:

US: 6-Methyl bromazepam is not listed specifically in the Schedules to the CSA and is not mentioned anywhere on the DEA website.

United Nations: 6-Methyl bromazepam is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control, nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status 6-Methyl bromazepam is not currently listed in the CDSA. However, the substance is claimed to be a related impurity of bromazepam and contains the core structure of a 1,4-benzodiazepine. Therefore, the substance is considered to be included under item 18 of Schedule IV to the CDSA under the heading "Benzodiazepines, their salts and derivatives, including".

Recommendation: 6-Methyl bromazepam is included under item 18 of Schedule IV to the CDSA and is a controlled substance.
