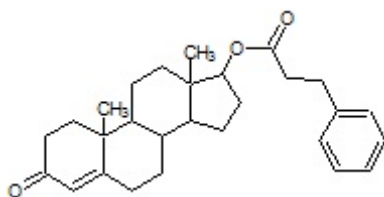
Drug: Testosterone phenylpropionate

Drug Name Status: Testosterone phenylpropionate is the common name.

Other Names: Testosterone 17-phenylpropionate

Chemical Name: (17-beta)-17-(1-Oxo-3-phenylpropoxy)-androst-4-en-3-one

Molecular Formula: C₂₈H₃₆O₃

Pharmacological class / Application: anabolic steroid derivative

International status:

US: The substance is currently listed on Schedule III to the US Controlled Substances Act.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: Item 23 of Schedule IV to the CDSA is, "Anabolic steroids and their derivatives." Subitem 23(40) is testosterone. Testosterone phenylpropionate is a derivative of testosterone (17-phenylpropionate ester) and is therefore included in item 23 of Schedule IV.

Recommendation: Testosterone phenylpropionate is included in item 23 of Schedule IV to the CDSA and is a controlled substance.
