
## Drug Status Report

**Drug:** Hydromorphone-3-sulfate

**Drug Name Status**: Hydromorphone-3-sulfate is the common name.

Chemical Name: (5alpha)-4,5-epoxy-17-methyl-3-(sulfooxy)morphinan-6-one

**Molecular Formula:** C<sub>17</sub>H<sub>19</sub>NO<sub>6</sub>S

Pharmacological class / Application: Metabolite of hydromorphone

CAS-RN: 479081-35-1

## **International status:**

US: Hydromorphone-3-sulfate is not currently listed in US Controlled Substances Act. However, the parent compound, hydromorphone, is included under Schedule II to the CSA.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control. However, hydromorphone is listed in Yellow List.

Canadian Status: Hydromorphone 3-sulfate is not listed specifically in the CDSA. However, the substance is a metabolite of hydromorphone which is currently listed as item 1(17) of Schedule I to the CDSA, under the heading "Opium Poppy (Papaver somniferum), its preparations, derivatives, alkaloids and salts, including:" As a metabolite of hydromorphone, the substance is therefore included under item 1(17) of schedule I to the CDSA as a derivative of hydromorphone.

**Recommendation:** Hydromorphone is item 1(17) of Schedule I to the CDSA and is a controlled substance.
