
Drug: Phenobarbital-ethyl-d5

Drug Name Status: Phenobarbital-ethyl-d5 is the common name.

Chemical Name: 5-(Ethyl-d5)-5-phenyl-2,4,6(1H,3H,5H)-pyrimidinetrione

Other Names: Pentobarbial-d5

International status:

US: The substance is not listed specifically in the Controlled Substances Act. However, phenobarbital is currently listed in Schedule IV to the CSA.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control. However, phenobarbital is listed in the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control

Canadian Status: The substance is not currently listed in the Schedules to the CDSA. However, the substance is a deuterated form of phenobarbital and consists of the core barbiturate structure. Phenobarbital is currently listed under item 1(21) of Schedule IV to the CDSA under the heading "Barbiturates, their salts and derivatives including:". As a derivative of phenobarbital, the substance is considered to be included under item 1(21) of Schedule IV to the CDSA.

Recommendation: Phenobarbital-ethyl-d5 is included under item 1(21) of Schedule IV to the

CDSA and is a controlled substance.
