The Act states :16. "Fentanyl, their salts, derivatives, and analogues and salts of derivatives and analogues", which this substance can not be considered to be

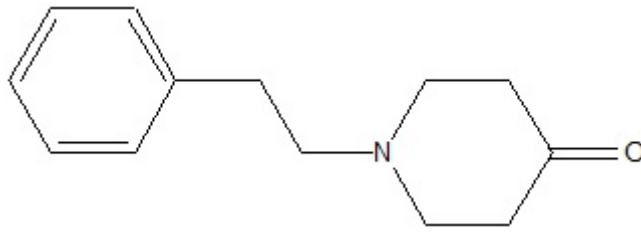
