



## STATUS DECISION OF CONTROLLED AND NON-CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE(S)

Substance: 1-Phenethylpiperidin-4-ol

Based on the current information available to the Office of Controlled Substances, it appears that the above substance is:

under the schedules of the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act* (CDSA) for the following reason(s):

- The substance is not listed in the schedules of the CDSA and can not be considered to belong to any family or group listed in the schedules.
- It has been listed as a byproduct in the production of N-phenyl-1-(2-phenethyl)-piperid-4-amine (a controlled substance) by the company requesting the status decision. It is produced by reduction of 1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidone. Therefore it can not be considered a derivative of the controlled substance..
- The Act states :16. "Fentanyls, their salts, derivatives, and analogues and salts of derivatives and analogues", which this substance can not be considered to be
