

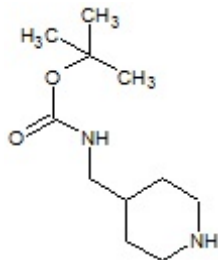
## Drug Status Report

**Drug:** 4-((Boc)-aminomethyl)-piperidine

**Drug Name Status:** 4-((Boc)-aminomethyl)-piperidine is the common name

**Chemical Name:** tert-Butyl-N-(4-piperidinylmethyl)carbamate

**Chemical structure:**



**Molecular Formula:** C<sub>11</sub>H<sub>22</sub>N<sub>2</sub>O<sub>2</sub>

**Pharmacological class / Application:** fine chemical

**International status:**

US: The substance is not listed on the schedules to the US Controlled Substances Act and is not mentioned on the DEA website.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control. The drug is not listed on the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: Piperidine and its salts is listed as a Class A precursor.

4-((Boc)-aminomethyl)-piperidine is not a salt of piperine so it is not included in the list of Class A precursors. It is also not similar to other substances listed on the schedules to the CDSA.

Recommendation: 4-((Boc)-aminomethyl)-piperidine is not included in the schedules to the CDSA and is not a controlled substance.
