## Drug Status Report

See - 5-Methoxy-N-methyl-N-isopropyltryptamine May 6, 2008

Drug: 5-MeO-MiPT

This was the name given by Food and Drug Inspector. Although acronyms are not usually used to prepare status reports, the context of the enquiry suggests the substance is 5-methoxy-methylisopropyltryptamine.

**Drug Name Status**: 5-MeO-MiPT is the common name.

Chemical Name: 3-[2-(N-Methyl-N-(1-methylethyl)amino]ethyl]-indole

Molecular Formula: C<sub>15</sub>H<sub>22</sub>N<sub>2</sub>O

Pharmacological class / Application: tryptamine analogue

## **International status:**

US: The substance is not currently listed on the schedules to the US Controlled Substances Act and is not mentioned on the DEA website.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: 5-MeO-MiPT is not listed on the schedules to the CDSA. There are three other tryptamines - diethyl; dimethyl; and etryptamine listed on Schedule III - items 6, 7 and 28. 5-MeO-MiPT is structurally very similar to 5-MeO-DIPT which is listed on Schedule I to the US Controlled Substances Act.

Recommendation: 5-MeO-MiPT is not included the schedules to the CDSA and is not a controlled substance.
