Pharmacological class / Application: antipsychotic

International status:

US: The substance is not listed specifically in the CSA and is not mentioned anywhere on the DEA website.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: Amisulpride is a considered to be an atypical or second-generation antipsychotic drug and has been shown to be effective in the treatment of psychotic conditions, particularly schizophrenia¹. Amisulpride is not listed specifically in the CDSA and is not structurally similar to any of the substances listed in the Schedules to the CDSA.

Recommendation: Amisulpride is not included in any of the schedules to the CDSA and is
