
## Drug Status Report

Drug: Dienogest

Drug Name Status: Dienogest is the proper (INN) name.

Chemical Name: 17-Hydroxy-3-oxo-19-nor-17alpha-pregna-4,9-diene-21-nitrile

Pharmacological class / Application: Steroid

## International status:

US: The substance is not listed specifically in the CSA and is not mentioned anywhere on the DEA website.

United Nations: The substance is not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control nor the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: Dienogest is a drug used in oral contraceptives and for the treatment of endometriosis<sup>1,2</sup>. The drug is not currently listed in the CDSA and has not been reported in the scientific literature to display any anabolic activity, nor derived from an anabolic steroid. Accordingly, dienogest cannot be included under item 23 of Schedule IV to the CDSA.

**Recommendation:** Dienogest is not included in the schedules to the CDSA and is not a controlled substance.
