## Drug Status Report

**Drug:** Huo Xiang Zheng

**Drug Name Status**: Huo Xiang Zheng is the brand name.

Huo Xiang Zheng is a herbal supplement that is used in traditional Chinese medicine (TCM) and is claimed to consist of primarily of *Ageratum*.

Ageratum is a plant genus which consists of more than 40 different species of plants. A. conyzoides is the most common Ageratum plant used in folk and traditional medicine in Africa, South America and some parts of Asia for treatment of a variety of diseases, ranging from headaches and infectious diseases, to wound healing, to skin diseases<sup>1</sup>. In traditional Chinese medicine, Huo Xiang Zheng is mainly used to treat cold symptoms<sup>2</sup>.

A wide variety of bioactive compounds have been reported in *A. conzyoides* and have been shown to produce anti-inflammatory, analgesic and antioxidant activities<sup>3,4</sup>. For example, sterols such as stigmasterol have been reported in the literature to produce anti-inflammatory effects<sup>1</sup> while a methanolic extract of *A. conzyoides* consisted of flavanoids that produced anti-inflammatory and antioxidant effects<sup>1,3,4</sup>.
