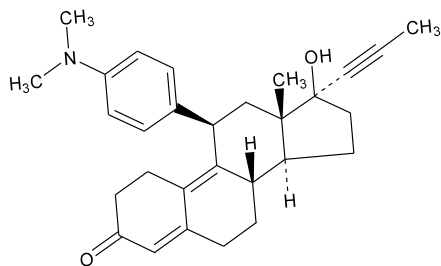
## Drug Status Report

**Drug Name Status:** Mifepristone is USAN; BAN and INN

**Pharmacological/chemical class / Application:** steroid/contraceptive

**International status:**

US: The drug is not currently listed on the US Controlled Substances Act and are not mentioned on the DEA website.

United Nations: The chemicals are not listed on the Yellow List - List of Narcotic Drugs under International Control. The drugs are not listed on the Green List - List of Psychotropic Substances under International Control.

Canadian Status: The drug is currently not listed specifically on the CDSA. Although a steroid, the drug has no reported anabolic activity.

Recommendation: Mifepristone is not included in the schedules to the CDSA and is not a controlled substance.
