

Fentanyls all have phenylamido groups attached at the 4 position of a piperidene ring, where the point of attachment is through the amide nitrogen.

All of the ampromides currently listed in Item 12 are 1,2-aminopropanamides.

The substance in question does not meet either of the above criteria, so it can not be considered under Item 12 or 16.
