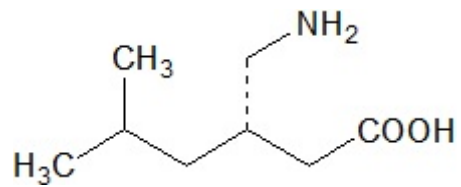
- The substance is not listed in the schedules of the CDSA and can not be considered to belong to any family or group listed in the schedules.
